In 2007, the Rural Grocery Initiative (RGI) was established to help address the loss of rural grocery stores. Housed within K-State Research and Extension, RGI aims to sustain locally owned rural grocery stores to enhance community vitality and improve access to healthy foods. - Support other tasks, as needed and assigned
